



APS "AMICI PER LA MUSICA" presents

THE 8TH EDITION OF THE LUIGI NONO COMPOSITION PRIZE

The winner will receive a 1000,00 Euro prize and a commission for a new piece, written for the winner of the "Premio Novecento" of the "Luigi Nono International Chamber Music Competition", 24th edition, 2021 yr.

Purpose of the prize is to promote contemporary chamber music and to create opportunities for composers and performers to meet.

RULES AND DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS

- ► The Call for Scores is open to composers in early stages of their career of any age and nationality (composers who haven't had major commissions, etc).
- Scores must be sent within June, 30th, 2021 at midnight (UTC/GMT+1), along with the application form duly and fully filled out to the following e-mail address: <u>iscrizioni@concorsoluiginono.com</u>
- Applications must be sent only by e-mail and must strictly include:
- 1. 2 (two) scores enclosed to the e-mail, in PDF format. The composer's name and any other identifying information must be removed. Scores with visible names will be rejected. The two scores can be either for solo instrument or chamber group (max 15 elements); electronic instrumentation is allowed. Scores can be either both for one instrument, or both for ensemble, or mixed, and can be written in any style and aesthetic. Duration for each score should be 5-15 minutes. Pieces can have already been performed and can have already been awarded a prize.
- 2. The MP3 (or Midi) recording of at least one of the pieces.
- 3. The filled in and signed application form.
- 4. The receipt of the contribution for management of competition: € 35,00 (non-refundable) to be paid to APS "Amici per la Musica"

- 5. The composer's Bio (in Italian or in English).





► PAY ATTENTION!!!

The composer's name and any other identifying information must be removed from the PDF files. Scores with visible names will be rejected. Please note that using black boxes to block out the name in Apple Preview is not effective, as the information can reappear on certain platforms, like Dropbox.

- The jury will choose a single winner, who will receive a prize of € 1000,00.
- ▶ In addition to that, the winner will be asked to compose a piece expressly for the musician/s, winner/s of the "Premio Novecento" (either soloist or group) awarded for the best performance of a piece composed after 1950, at the 24th edition of the "Luigi Nono International Chamber Music Competition", taking place from October 22nd through October 24th, 2021.
- The commissioned piece will be premiered by the winner/s of the "PREMIO NOVECENTO" in a concert within the 2022 musical season, organized by APS "Amici per la Musica". The composer will be invited to attend the premiere, but the presence is not mandatory. APS "Amici per la Musica" can support travel costs up to 500 €.
- ► The name of the winner will **be posted** on the Facebook page and on the website of APS "Amici per la Musica" (www.amiciperlamusica.com) within the beginning of the "Luigi Nono International Chamber Music Competition (October 22nd, 2021)".

The results will be also announced during the awarding ceremony of the above-mentioned competition, Sunday, October 24th 2021. The winner will be informed by e-mail, as well.
